Plan Ahead Grant Update:

ASAC was awarded a grant from the State of Tennessee called The Plan Ahead Project in October 2020. This grant is a two-year project that has allowed us to expand our education offerings throughout all of our Tennessee counties. We have made some amazing progress and look forward to continuing our work in these areas.

At the end of Year One, ASAC met and exceeded all of our metrics for this grant and we are off to an amazing start for Year Two.

During the first year, our Health Educators connected with 7,465 individuals throughout our Tennessee service area through outreach and education opportunities, we established 182 new partnerships with a variety of organizations who also provide assistance and information throughout our service area and we saw 771 individuals connect to needed clinical services.
